
2023-24 Virtual Education Program Annual Report

The Background:

Annually, the Tennessee Department of Education releases a report to highlight the state of virtual education in Tennessee. This year's report provides information relative to the operation and outcomes of public virtual schools and virtual education programs for the 2023-24 school year. In compliance with T.C.A. § 49-16-104, the report provides information relative to student enrollment, academic performance, and funding for virtual education and includes data for public virtual schools and their establishing local education agencies (LEAs).
