Automatic Licensure Actions

- A. Linda Fields Automatic and Permanent Prohibition on Reactivation Pleaded guilty to child neglect in Mississippi and court ordered to permanently surrender Mississippi teaching license.
- B. Ashley Cansler Automatic Permanent Prohibition on Reactivation Kentucky license was permanently revoked pursuant to agreed order due to an alleged inappropriate relationship with a student. Pleaded guilty in Kentucky to 2nd degree Unlawful Transaction with a Minor, a class D felony The Tennessee equivalent would fall under the automatic sections for a felony offense in title 39, chapter 13 and a sexual offense as described in 40-39-202.
- C. Alissa McCommon Automatic Permanent Revocation Pleaded guilty to numerous criminal offenses including Rape of a Child (T.C.A. § 39-13-522), Statutory Rape by an Authority Figure (T.C.A. § 39-13-532), Aggravated Statutory Rape (T.C.A. § 39-13-506), Sexual Exploitation of a Minor by Electronic Means (T.C.A. § 39-13-529), and Solicitation of a Minor (T.C.A. § 39-13-528), and was required to register as a sex offender and have her educator license revoked.
- D. Benjamin Work Automatic Permanent Prohibition on Reactivation Convicted of multiple counts of sexual exploitation of minor students in Iowa and required to register as a sex offender.
