I. General Assessment Requirements

- (1) Individuals seeking educator licensure in Tennessee shall submit, as applicable, qualifying scores on required assessments to demonstrate applicable pedagogical and specialty content area knowledge and skills.
- (2) The Department of Education (Department) shall provide guidance to support licensure reactivation timelines and requirements.

II. Pedagogical Assessments

- (1) Individuals seeking initial educator licensure in Tennessee shall submit qualifying scores on the edTPA or Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) assessment, both of which measure pedagogical knowledge and are aligned to Tennessee's professional education standards unless otherwise set forth below.
- (2) Beginning July 1, 2026, individuals seeking educator licensure in Tennessee through enrollment in or completion of a State Board of Education (State Board) approved educator preparation program with a Department approved clinical practice shall not be required to take a pedagogical assessment for licensure. Individuals seeking licensure on or after July 1, 2026 who completed a State Board approved educator preparation program prior to the clinical practice being approved by the Department shall be required to submit qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment in accordance with this policy.
- (3) Pedagogical assessment timelines and expectations for submitting qualifying scores are detailed in Department guidance.
 - (a) Individuals applying for an initial teacher license shall submit qualifying scores on the applicable edTPA assessment:

- (b) Educator Preparation Providers (EPPs) may request that a candidate participate in an alternate edTPA if the clinical practice placement is more closely aligned with another edTPA.

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- (c) For individuals applying for an initial teacher license in an endorsement area that does not have an applicable edTPA assessment, submission of a qualifying score on the appropriate Principles of Learning and Teaching assessment is required.
- ~~(d) Candidates completing programs approved for licensure in Tennessee may submit the appropriate Principals of Learning and Teaching assessment in lieu of edTPA if taken on or before 12/31/2018. Scores will be accepted through 1/1/2024.~~

- (2) Beginning June 1, 2023, the submission of qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment is not required for individuals seeking to renew or advance a practitioner teacher license following completion of a State-Board approved educator preparation program with a job-embedded clinical practice.
- (3) Beginning June 1, 2025, the submission of qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment is not required for individuals seeking to reactivate a practitioner teacher license following completion of a State Board approved educator preparation program with a job-embedded clinical practice.
- (4) Individuals seeking issuance of a Tennessee practitioner teacher license through out-of-state pathway 1 or who are seeking renewal or advancement of a Tennessee practitioner license through out-of-state pathway 3 (as set forth in State Board Rule 0520-02-03-.03) shall submit qualifying scores on the appropriate PLT or the edTPA.
- (5) Individuals who are seeking or who obtained a Tennessee practitioner or professional teacher license through out-of-state pathways 2, 4, or 5 are not required to submit qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment for issuance, renewal, advancement, or reactivation of the license.
- (6) The submission of qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment is not required for individuals seeking a school services personnel license.
- (7) The submission of qualifying scores on a pedagogical assessment or specialty area content assessment is not required for individuals seeking an adjunct license.

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- (8) Individuals enrolled in specialty area programs leading to more than one (1) endorsement shall only be required to submit qualifying scores on one (1) edTPA.

III. Specialty Area Content Assessments

- (1) Individuals seeking educator licensure in Tennessee shall demonstrate specialty area content knowledge for all endorsements sought.
- (2) Individuals seeking licensure and/or endorsement shall submit qualifying scores on all appropriate specialty area content knowledge assessments, as identified below.

- (3) Beginning June 1, 2023, the submission of qualifying scores on a specialty area content assessment is not required for individuals seeking to renew the practitioner teacher license or advance from the practitioner teacher license to the professional teacher license if:

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- (a) The educator has completed a State Board-approved educator preparation program with a job-embedded clinical practice; and
 - (b) The educator obtained the practitioner license and endorsement by demonstrating that they hold a degree with a major aligned to a qualifying middle or secondary core academic or World Language endorsement. Qualifying endorsements and assessments are identified in bold in Tables 3 and 4 of this policy section.
- (4) Beginning June 1, 2023, the submission of qualifying scores on a specialty area content assessment is not required for individuals seeking a practitioner teacher license if:
- (a) The educator has completed a State Board-approved educator preparation program; and
 - (b) The educator demonstrates that they hold a degree with a major aligned to a qualifying middle or secondary core academic or World Language endorsement for which they are seeking licensure and endorsement. Qualifying endorsements and assessments are identified in bold in Tables 3 and 4 of this policy section.
- (5) The Department ~~will~~must produce and release guidance to support the implementation of paragraphs (3) and (4) of this policy section.
- (6) Individuals seeking the license for postsecondary educators shall submit qualifying scores on the assessment required for the 6-12 endorsement in the equivalent specialty content area.
- (7) Unless exempted under paragraph (3) or (4) of this policy section, individuals seeking any pre-K-12 or 6-12 World Languages endorsement shall submit qualifying scores on either the appropriate Praxis Series assessment or the appropriate Alta Language Services Speaking and Listening Assessment, and Written Assessment, administered by the Tennessee Language Center. For individuals seeking an endorsement in World Languages for which there is not an applicable Praxis Series assessment, submission of a qualifying score on the appropriate Alta Language Services Speaking and Listening Assessment is required. Based on candidate documented proficiency, English assessments may not be required.

IV. Foundational Literacy Skills Assessment

- (1) Pursuant to the Tennessee Literacy Success Act, educators seeking to obtain or maintain K-5 endorsements identified in the Educator Licensure Policy 5.502 shall either pass a required foundational skills literacy assessment as identified below or complete a Department-approved foundational literacy skills professional development course prior to obtaining the endorsement or maintaining the endorsement on a license that is being renewed or advanced. State Board of Education Educator Licensure Rule 0520-02-03-.11 provides additional details regarding how an educator may obtain and maintain licensure and endorsement in endorsement areas identified in the Educator Licensure Policy 5.502.
