

Top Producers of High-Demand Endorsements

The annual Educator Preparation Report Card presents data on the State Board's key priority areas for preparing educators for Tennessee. One of these priorities is preparing candidates to teach in the areas of greatest need. Data analysis by the Tennessee Department of Education identified several subject areas with especially high demand relative to supply. These high-demand areas include Special Education (Modified, Comprehensive, and Interventionist), English as a Second Language, Secondary Math (6-10 and 6-12), Secondary Science (Biology, Chemistry, and Physics), and Spanish. This document highlights the educator preparation providers (EPPs) that trained the most new teachers in these areas over a three year period (2018-19, 2019-20, and 2020-21).

Please note that the numbers shown here include only teachers earning initial licensure. Teachers who returned to an EPP to earn an additional endorsement are not included in these counts.
