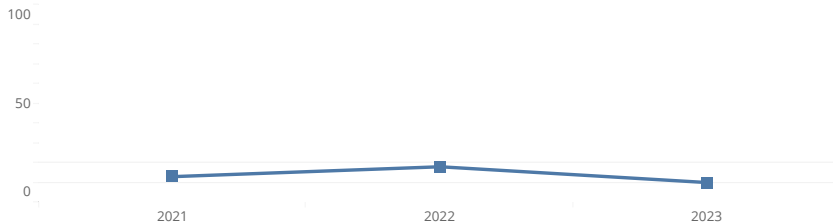

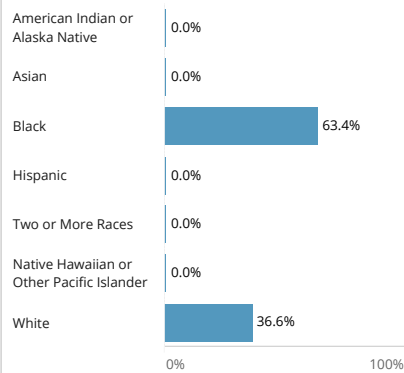

This metric indicates the number of cohort members in each of the three years included in this report card.

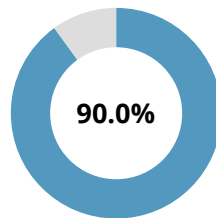
Completers by Race

Praxis Leader Licensure Pass Rate

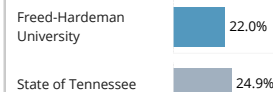
