The Carter & Moyers School of Education at Lincoln Memorial University (LMU) offers graduate-level Instructional Leadership programs at the Master of Education (MEd) and Educational Specialist (EdS) levels, aligned with the Tennessee Instructional Leadership Standards (TILS). These programs prepare current educators to lead in public or private school settings. The MEd in Instructional Leadership is a fully online 33-credit hour program culminating in a clinical experience and capstone portfolio submission. The EdS in Instructional Leadership is a 30-credit hour program offered online or in a hybrid format, also culminating in a clinical experience and capstone portfolio submission. All Instructional Leadership completers are required to complete the School Leadership Licensure Assessment (SLLA) for licensure.
