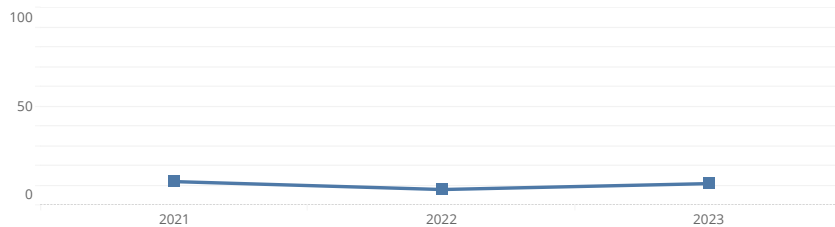

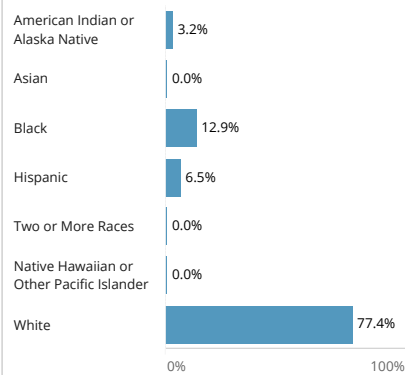

**Cohort Members per Year**

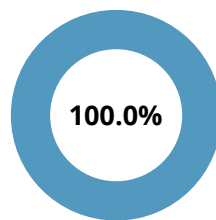

**Completers by Race****What is this metric?**

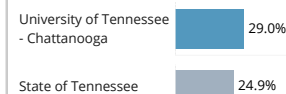
This metric shows the racial and ethnic composition of the three-year cohort.
