ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Daniel Doyle (“Respondent”) was licensed by the State Board of Education (“Board”) as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.
2. During the 2011-2012 school year, Respondent was employed with Huntingdon Special School District.
3. During the 2011-2012 school year, Respondent was employed as a teacher at Huntingdon High School.
4. On January 26, 2012, Respondent was dismissed from Huntingdon Special School District for misconduct with a student.
5. Respondent was subsequently convicted of statutory rape by an authority figure, a Class E Felony, in the Carroll County Circuit Court.
6. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board’s intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice, and through counsel, requested that the Board hold this licensure action until the conclusion of Respondent’s appeal of his criminal conviction. In October 2014, Respondent, through counsel, notified the Board that the conviction of statutory rape is now final and a judgment has been entered.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent’s conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(1).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent’s license. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.

Respondent may not apply for reinstatement until three (3) years from the effective date of this order. Restoration shall be at the discretion of the Board, pursuant to Policy 5.500.


