ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On February 15, 2013, Marcos Flores (Respondent) resigned during Williamson County School's investigation of inappropriate conduct.
2. On June 26, 2015, Respondent pled guilty to seven (7) felony charges in Williamson County.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation, suspension, or reprimand pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(a).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license as of the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or

be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
