ORDER OF REVOCATION

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. At all times pertinent hereto, Stephanie Cole ("Respondent") was a licensed teacher in the State of Tennessee.
- 2. On March 2, 2016, Respondent was convicted of first degree murder (felony) and sentenced to life in prison.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to T.C.A. §§ 49-5-417 and 40-35-501(i)(2)(A) and Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(1), (2)(a), and (2)(f), Respondent's license is subject to automatic revocation.

ORDER

The Board hereby revokes Respondent's educator license effective on the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position during the period of revocation. Restoration of Respondent's license shall be at the discretion of the Board, pursuant to Board policy 5.500 – License Restoration Policy.
