**ORDER OF RESTORATION**

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. In 2015, Respondent’s license was revoked for directing another educator to sign an administrator’s signature on IEPs.
2. On July 5, 2018, Respondent submitted her application to restore her Tennessee educator license. Since the revocation of her license, Respondent has been working in post-secondary education as STEM Success Center Manager at Maryville College overseeing students that were awarded scholarships from National Science Foundation and managing the tutor center. Respondent also works as an adjunct professor at Pellissippi State Community College teaching academic and professional reading and college success. Respondent has a support letter from Blount County who was aware of the situation that lead to her license being revoked.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(6)(b) and Board Policy 5.500 License Restoration Policy, Respondent’s license is subject to restoration.

**ORDER**

The Board hereby restores Respondent’s educator license. Provided other requirements for licensure are satisfied, the Office of Educator Licensing and Preparation (“OELP”) may issue and/or renew Respondent’s license.
