ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. From May 30, 2013 to May 30, 2016, Adam Floyd (“Respondent”) had his certificate to teach in the state of Georgia suspended for engaging in an inappropriate romantic relationship with a student.
2. On April 3, 2017, the Office of Educator Licensing (“OEL”) received Respondent’s application for a Tennessee educator license.
3. On June 22, 2017, Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board’s intent to deny his application for a Tennessee educator license based upon these findings and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received the certified letter but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent’s conduct constitutes grounds for license suspension, revocation or refusal to issue or renew a license pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-1-302(a)(5)(A)(iv) and Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(e).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby denies Respondent’s application a Tennessee educator license effective on the date of this order. Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position without a Tennessee educator license.
