ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Haley Beasley (“Respondent”) was licensed by the State Board of Education (“Board”) as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.
2. On March 13, 2013, Respondent voluntarily surrendered her Georgia teaching license based upon allegations of inappropriate conduct and communication with students, unprofessional conduct, and drug/alcohol possession on school property.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board’s intent to revoke her license based upon these findings. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent’s conduct constitutes grounds for revocation or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent’s license concurrent with the Georgia revocation. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
