ORDER OF RESTORATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In 2017, Monrita Tate’s (“Respondent”) Tennessee educator license was revoked due to two pending criminal charges of assault. The revocation occurred prior to the resolution of Respondent’s criminal case. Ultimately, one assault charge was dismissed without prosecution. Respondent was found not guilty by a jury of the second count of assault.
2. On September 20, 2019, Respondent submitted her application to restore her Tennessee educator license. She provided court documents showing that her criminal case had resolved without a conviction. Further, the records regarding her case have since been expunged.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(6)(b) and Board Policy 5.500 License Restoration Policy, Respondent’s license is subject to restoration.

ORDER

The Board hereby restores Respondent’s educator license. Provided other requirements for licensure are satisfied, the Office of Educator Licensing and Preparation (“OELP”) may issue and/or renew Respondent’s license.
