CONSENT ORDER

By agreement of the Tennessee State Board of Education ("Board") and Angelia Stang ("Respondent"), this matter is disposed of, pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3) as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Respondent was a licensed educator in the State of Tennessee.
2. On March 21, 2018, Lauderdale County Schools reported that, during the 2017-2018 school year, specifically on March 20, 2018, Respondent engaged in inappropriate physical contact with student(s) at Ripley Primary School. Specifically, Respondent struck a non-verbal, special education student and dragged said student across the floor into the classroom on two separate occasions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation of her license pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3)(e), (3)(g), and (3)(h).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby orders, and Respondent agrees to the following:

1. Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender her educator license in Tennessee.
2. As a condition of the surrender, Respondent has agreed that he will not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
3. Respondent agrees not to apply for reinstatement until five (5) years from approval of this licensure action by the Board. Restoration shall be at the discretion of the Board, pursuant to Board policy 5.500.
4. Approval of this Consent Order by the Board shall in no way be construed as condoning the Respondent's conduct and shall not be construed as a waiver of any of the lawful rights possessed by the Board.
5. This Consent Order shall not become effective until approved by the Board, and Respondent understands that this Consent Order will not become effective until approved by the Board.

6. Respondent must always answer affirmatively to the question on licensure applications regarding having been suspended, denied or revoked.
7. Respondent acknowledges that she has read this Consent Order and that she understands its contents.
8. Respondent understands that there is a right to a hearing in this matter, and Respondent knowingly and voluntarily waives such right by entering into this Consent Order.
9. Respondent further understands and agrees that the Board shall have the authority to review the investigative file and all relevant evidence in considering this Consent Order.
10. Respondent further understands that this Consent Order, once approved, shall constitute a public record that may be disseminated as a disciplinary action of the Board, which includes, but is not limited to reporting this action to the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Educator and Certification ("NASDTEC") and posting on the Board website pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 49-1-302(p), (q).
11. If this Consent Order is not approved by the Board, it shall not constitute an admission against interest in this proceeding, or prejudice the ability of the Board to adjudicate this matter.
12. The Respondent hereby consents to the terms and sanctions contained herein.
