
Creation or Reactivation of City School Systems, Rule 0520-01-08

The Background:

The State Board of Education adopted the Creation or Reactivation of City School Systems rule in 1992. This policy was revised in February 1999, but it has not been revised since.

This item proposes minor changes to the rule to bring it up to date with current statute and practices. Key changes to the rule include:

- Changes “superintendent” to “director of schools”.
- Eliminates outdated salary requirements for directors of schools and teachers.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department of Education prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends acceptance of this item on first reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
