Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation (TSAC) Defaults

---

**The Background:**

Pursuant to State Board of Education Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(f), the State Board of Education must suspend a license for default on a student loan pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-5-108(d)(2). The Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation (TSAC) determines that individuals have defaulted on a state or federal educational loan or service-conditional scholarship guaranteed or administered by TSAC, and after having received proper notice have failed to comply with Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1640-01-23, as authorized by Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-4-210, directs the Board to suspend any active licenses.

**The Recommendation:**

The Board staff recommends renewal of the action taken during the January, 2016, meeting to conduct TSAC related suspensions on a rolling basis, until such time as the automatic suspension provision of the updated teacher disciplinary rule (as passed in October, 2016) takes effect.

The Board staff review committee recommends suspension of Respondents' teaching licenses until such time as they come into compliance with payment of student loans.
