
Creation or Reactivation of City School Systems, Rule 0520-01-08

The Background:

The State Board of Education adopted the Creation or Reactivation of City School Systems rule in 1992. This rule was revised in February 1999, but it has not been revised since.

On first reading, this item proposed minor changes to the rule to bring it up to date with current statute and practices, including:

- Changes “superintendent” to “director of schools”.
- Eliminates outdated salary requirements for directors of schools and teachers.

There have been no changes since first reading.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department of Education prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends adoption of this item on final reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
