Ladies and Gentlemen:

Each year the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation releases annual reports of crimes reported by law enforcement agencies to the Tennessee Incident Based Reporting System (TIBRS) program in eight different reports. The TIBRS data contains a wide range of incident level information including victim and offender demographics.

Incident-based reporting views a crime and all of its components as an "incident." Information about the crime, including details of the offense, victim, offender, property, arrestees, and the relationship between the people involved, are all reported. Because of the extent of detailed data collected, the TIBRS program provides an even more accurate depiction of crime in each community than the Uniform Crime Report (UCR) published by the FBI.

The CJIS Support Center staff continually review the crime data reported to TBI. One of the areas of particular interest are incidents involving firearms across the state. This report includes information on the crime, the offenders and the victims in incidents when firearms were reported as part of the event.

I would like to thank all participating law enforcement agencies for their hard work and contributions to making the TIBRS program successful in Tennessee. It is only with their support that our state continues to provide our citizens information about crime occurring in our state.

INTRODUCTION


This report will analyze a four-year crime trend regarding firearm offenses reported to the Tennessee Incident Based Reporting System (TIBRS) by Tennessee law enforcement agencies. Information obtained from TIBRS has been verified by reporting agencies for accuracy. This report will illustrate specific information for violent crimes, such as Crimes Against Persons using firearms.

For the purpose of this study, only the weapon type listed as Firearm in TIBRS will be considered for this report. TIBRS defines Firearms as weapons that fire a shot by force of an explosion, i.e. Handguns, Rifles, Shotguns, Flare Guns, etc. Other weapons, such as Knife/Cutting Instruments, Poison, Explosives, and Fire/Incendiary Devices are excluded.

QUICK FACTS

- From 2021 to 2024, Firearm Offenses decreased 9.04%.
- Handgun made up the largest segment of weapon type used.
- Aggravated Assault and Robbery accounted for the most reported Group A offenses.
- Residence/Home locations accounted for 54.23% of reported locations indicating the most common location type for Firearm Offenses.
- Sunday (17.47%) and Saturday (15.81%) had the greatest reported number of Firearm Offenses.
- The most commonly reported time frame for Firearm Offenses to occur was 9:00pm-11:59pm.
- Males were nearly six times more likely to engage in firearm offenses than Females.
- The most prevalent Offender Age category for Firearm Offenses was 18-24.
- Of the 105,369 Victims reported 57.11% were Male and 42.89% were Female.
- Stranger made up the largest Victim to Offender Relationship type from 2021 to 2024

FOUR YEAR ANALYSIS



This study provides a four year review of offenses reported as crimes involving a Firearm. Of the 100,349 crimes reported in this study period, data showed an overall 9.04% decrease from 2021 to 2024, although reported crimes fluctuated in this period. The lowest number of reported crimes occurred in 2024 with 23,721.

Handguns made up the largest category every year from 2021-2024 though it did show a 15.41% drop in reports during the time frame. While the majority of weapon categories showed a decrease from 2021 to 2024, Firearm (Type Not Stated), Firearm-Automatic (Type Not Stated), and Rifle-Automatic all showed an upward trend from 2023 to 2024.

The table above breaks down the number of offenses where a firearm may be reported. The most reported offenses throughout the four years were consistently Aggravated Assault and Robbery, though both have decreased since 2021, 7.83% and 15.17% respectively. 2024 showed four year lows for every type of relevant offense except Negligent Manslaughter which was at a high, increasing 21.05% since 2021.



Another facet of data examined in relationship to Firearm Offenses is the time of day in which said offenses occur. This data revealed that the majority of offenses every year occurred in the evening into the night, with 9:00pm-11:59pm and 6:00pm-8:59pm being the most commonly represented time frames with 20.67% and 18.84% of reports respectively. Conversely, the morning hours of 6:00am-8:59am consistently had the fewest number of reports, representing 4.37% reports over the four year period.


Examining where Firearm Offenses have occurred reveals that 83.40% were reported at one of three location types, Residence/Home (54.23%), Highway/Road/Alley (18.67%), and Parking Lot/Garage (10.50%).

Firearm Offenses by Day of the Week



Firearm Offenses were primarily reported as having had occurred on weekends from 2021-2024 with Sunday and Saturday having the majority of reports at 17.47% and 15.81% of total reports respectively. 2024 showed an overall drop in amount of reports since 2021 of every day of the week with the largest decrease being Fridays, which dropped 16.57%.

Firearm Offenses by Offender Sex




From 2021 to 2024, there were a total of 81,257 instances where an offender's sex was reported to TIBRS. Of those, 72.50% were Male, making them nearly six times more likely to commit a Firearm Offense than a Female (12.14%). The sex of the remaining 15.36% of Offenders was Unknown.

Examining offenders of Firearm Offenses by age reveals that offenders tended to be from the younger age groups of 18-24 and 25-34, that accounted for 34.04% and 33.58% of reported ages respectively. 2024 showed an overall decrease in each category except the group of 65 and over, which showed a steady increase throughout the four year period, increasing 23.87% from 2021 to reach a four-year peak in 2024.



From 2021 to 2024 there were a total of 105,369 instances where a firearm victim's sex was reported. Of these, 60,173 (57.11%) were Male while the remaining 45,196 (42.89%) were Female. Victims of both sexes were reported at a four year low with the amount of Male victims decreasing 9.81% and Female victims decreasing 7.02% since 2021.

From 2021 to 2024, a total of 39,078 Females were reported as victims of Aggravated Assault with a firearm. Aggravated Assault amounts to 86.46% of all reported Firearm Offenses against Female Victims over that time period. Despite Aggravated Assault being the most common offense type, there was a 5.93% overall decrease of those offenses reported against women from 2021 to 2024. The only crime that showed an increase of Female Victims was Negligent Manslaughter, which increased 60.00% from 2021.



Similar to the reporting of Female Victims, from 2021 to 2024, a total of 36,110 Males were reported as victims of Aggravated Assault with a firearm. Aggravated Assault amounts to 76.63% of all reported Firearm Offenses against Male Victims over that time period. Despite Aggravated Assault being the most common offense type, there was a 9.58% overall decrease of those offenses reported against men from 2021 to 2024. The only crimes that showed an increase of Male Victims were Criminal Sexual Contact and Negligent Manslaughter, which increased 100.00% and 7.14% from 2021 respectively.

From 2021 to 2024, 17,770 victims were reported that were under the age of 18. Of these, 16,115, or 90.69%, juveniles were victims of Aggravated Assault with a Firearm. While overall offenses showed a 6.12% decrease from 2021 to 2024 overall, a few offenses showed an increase. Notably, Murder with a Firearm increased 6.82% from 2021, however there was a 26.56% drop from 2023.



Another facet of data tracked with Firearm Offenses is the Victim to Offender Relationship. From 2021 to 2024, the most frequently reported relationship type was Stranger with 45.14% of reports during the time period. The second most reported relationship type was Acquaintance at 30.91%.

Note: Up to five different Injury Types may be reported in each incident and up to three Weapon Types may be reported per offense. Data retrieved from TIBRS does not differentiate which injury was caused by which weapon.

When examining the type of injury resulting from a Firearm Offense, 84,014, or 82.57% listed None as the injury, indicating that in the majority of Firearm Offenses, the offender simply displayed the firearm during the offense rather than used it. Beyond this, the two most common injury types were Apparent Minor Injury with 8.66% of reports, and Other Major Injury with 5.56%.

Conclusion

The data showed 100,349 reported Firearm Offenses from 2021 to 2024, signifying a 9.04% decrease during the period. Handguns were the most common Firearm type reported, however there was a 15.41% drop since 2021. Aggravated Assault and Robbery were the two most commonly reported offense types involving a firearm, though, yet again, they showed a decrease of 7.83% and 15.17% respectively. The most common location type for Firearm Offenses to occur was Residence/Home, with 54.23% of all reported location types. The only Firearm Offense to show an increase during the study period was Negligent Manslaughter, increasing 21.05% since 2021.

The weekend had the highest number of Firearm Offenses with Saturday having 15.81% and Sunday having 17.47%. Looking at time of day showed the most predominate time frame to be 9:00pm-11:59pm with 20.67% of reports. Males (72.50%) were nearly six times more likely to commit a Firearm Offense than Females (12.14%). The remaining 15.36% of offenders were reported as Sex being Unknown. When examining the age of Offenders, it can be seen that the most common age group was 18-24, with 34.04% of offenders. From 2021 to 2024, a total of 105,369 victims were reported with 57.11% of those being Male and 42.89% being Female. The most common Victim to Offender Relationship type with Firearm Offenses was Stranger with 45.14% or reports. Of the eight reportable injury types, None made up the vast majority of reports with 82.57% of reported injuries, indicating firearms were more often displayed rather than actually used in Firearm Offenses.
