# DNA Collection: An Overview





### In CODIS Terms

When a person is arrested for violent felonies that qualify under the Arrestee Law (TCA 40-35-321(e)(1)), a DNA sample is collected.

The sample can be collected by either the arresting or booking agency.



### TCA Code 40-35-321 (e)(1)

"When a person is arrested on or after January 1, 2008, for the commission of a violent felony as defined in subdivision (e)(3), the person shall have a biological specimen taken for the purpose of DNA analysis to determine identification characteristics specific to the person."



#### How do I obtain Arrestee DNA Kits?

- •Each agency should designate one individual responsible for ordering and maintaining Arrestee DNA kits.
- •We ship out kits based on your agency's current monthly average.
- •Order kits as often as necessary and the average will be adjusted accordingly.
- Do not wait until your agency is completely out of kits to reorder. Once your agency is down to one-third the kits you have received, go ahead and contact us so the new shipment will arrive before you run out.



# How do I obtain Arrestee DNA Kits? (Cont'd.)

- Email TBLCODIS@tn.gov to order kits. Include your name, your agency's name, full address and phone number, as well as the type of kit you are requesting.
- Kits will be shipped to you via FedEx Ground and typically arrive within 2-3 business days.
- They are also available at Evidence Receiving in the Nashville Crime Lab, but if you want to pick up more than 10, we ask you to contact the CODIS unit at least 24 hours in advance as the stock kept on-hand in Evidence Receiving is low.



### Additional Notes

- Make sure that the individual is charged with one of the qualifying TCA Codes.
- Please note: As of May 10, 2012, 6 new qualifying offenses were added to the list.
- A complete list is available on the back of the middle envelope of each Arrestee kit, as well as on the TBI website.

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




# I have my kit...now what?!?!? (Cont'd)

- Each kit has everything needed to collect from one individual.
- Inside the white mailing envelope you will find a middle white envelope with instructions and qualifying offenses, a pair of biohazard barrier gloves, proper seals, four swabs, swab envelope, and an Arrestee DNA Sample Submittal Form.

• It is not necessary for Medical Personnel to collect this sample.





#### Put on biohazard barrier gloves.





#### Read the instructions on the middle envelope carefully.





Have the Arrestee rinse their mouth out if they have been eating or chewing tobacco prior to collection.



Open one swab package at a time.




Using one swab at a time, rub the inside of the individual's cheek for 5 to 10 seconds.



Use all 4 swabs and both sides of the mouth.



The swab packet can be used to rest the swabs on as they air dry.



Allow the swabs to air dry at least 1-2 minutes before packaging.



# Place all 4 swabs inside the small white envelope bulb end down.



Do not place swabs back into the paper wrappers from which they came.



# Seal the small swab envelope with one of the red seals.





# Remember this is not evidence even though the seal says "Evidence".





# DO NOT LICK ENVELOPE TO SEAL!!









The person collecting the sample, **not the Arrestee**, should initial and date the seal.




Use a Sharpie or ball point pen to write initials.

Gel pens tend to smear.



# DO NOT write on the swab envelope other than the initials and date on the seal.








# Place small swab envelope into the middle white envelope.



Do not staple paperwork to swab envelope!



#### Seal with the middle envelope with the remaining red seal.





#### Initial and date the 2<sup>nd</sup> seal on the middle envelope.





Fill out all of the requested information on the Arrestee DNA Sample Submittal Form.

### **PLEASE Print Legibly**

The Submittal Form may be hand written or filled out electronically.

### **Juveniles**

If the arrestee is a Juvenile at the time of arrest, you must notate that he/she will be bound over as an adult.

You must include a copy of the Bound Over paperwork.

Writing "Adjudicated Juvenile" is not sufficient.



### Thumb Prints


Please do not include 10 print cards as a substitute or indicate that they are "On file".


It is the agency's responsibility to acquire ink pads for the purpose of collecting the Arrestee's thumb prints.


No special ink is necessary such as UV ink. Any color is acceptable as long as we can see ridge detail in the thumb print.

If you do not have an ink pad, email **TBI.CODIS**(a) tn.gov and we can ship one to you.
















### An Example of Acceptable Prints

After the thumb prints are dry, make a copy of the completed form for your records. Fold submittal form and put the form and the middle white sealed envelope into the larger mailing envelope.







To prevent paperwork contamination, please do not put paperwork inside the middle envelope with the swab envelope.




#### Seal the outer mailing envelope with the kit shipping seal.








Put return address on the mailing envelope even if you are hand delivering kits.



If you are collecting the sample for an arresting agency, put the Arresting Agency name on the mailing envelope.




If being mailed, please attach the proper postage.



The US Postal Service considers the kits to be a package and, as of March 2019, charges \$3.50 per kit to ship.



If you are planning to mail multiple kits at once in a larger package, please note that the U.S. Postal Service requires you to have either the biohazard symbol, or "BIOHAZARD" written out on the outer packaging.





The remains of the seals may be disposed of in regular trash.





The swab packets (if used in the drying of the swabs) and biohazard barrier gloves should be disposed of by following your departments recommended OSHA procedures.






Please do not put the used gloves back in the envelope to be mailed back with the kit.



# The kit is ready to be hand delivered or mailed to TBI Nashville


Due to the sensitive nature of Arrestee DNA, kits should be hand delivered or mailed in a timely manner.






If an Arrestee kit is sent in as evidence (the kit plainly states that it is not to be used as evidence) the sample will not be worked and the submitting officer will be contacted and told that the sample is not acceptable.







If a sample is collected from an individual who does not meet the qualifications or if the paperwork is not filled out COMPLETELY and CORRECTLY, the kit will be returned to the submitting agency for correction and re-submittal.



### Arrestee Kit Returns

- •If a kit is returned to your Agency, please check to see why it is being returned.
- •A memo is included with each kit with an explanation as to why it was returned to you.
- •Please correct the paperwork, reseal the envelope with tape and initial. Return kit to the lab for processing.
- **DO NOT** collect a whole new kit or take another kit apart to use the mailing envelope.



### A Few Things To Keep In Mind

- •Be familiar with the instructions before starting
- •To avoid a potential mix-up, please only process one kit at a time
- •Arrestees are not allowed to swab or print themselves
- •Arrestees are not allowed to fill out the paperwork or initial the seals
- •Place the swabs in the swab envelope bulb end down
- •Do not touch the cotton bulb of the swab
- •Buccal samples should be handled and processed as if they are potentially biohazardous.
- •If you realize that you have left something out of the kit, you may open the kit and reseal with tape.
- •Once sent to the lab, the profile obtained from this sample will be put into the Arrestee Database





There is no chain of custody on this kit.

This collection kit is not evidence.

IT SHOULD NOT BE USED TO COLLECT EVIDENCE.
