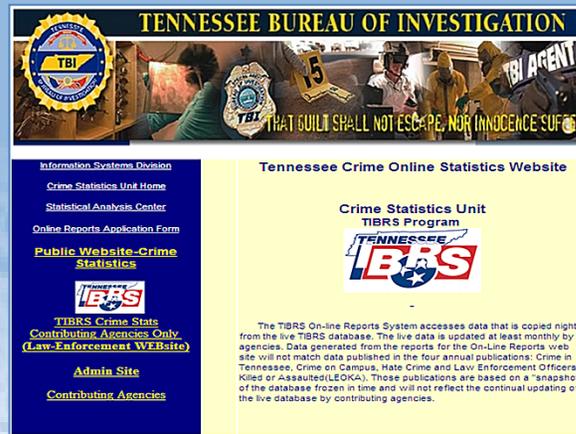
## What Is It?

TnCrimeOnline is a web-based tool that contains 2 websites: Public site & TIBRS Agency site

- Public site – allows general public and media to access data that has been cleared by TIBRS agencies.
- TIBRS Contributor site –allows law enforcement agencies/colleges/universities to have access to current TIBRS data for their agency, county, region and state. Agency data can be displayed at the incident level. Requires an account with username and password – 1 per agency/college/ university

## How Do I Use It?

For the contributor site, agencies must obtain a username and password from the Crime Statistics Unit. Go to [www.tncrimeonline.com](http://www.tncrimeonline.com) and login (see access details to the right). Double click any of the existing reports to generate data for your agency. All TIBRS reports can be modified to suit your agency's law enforcement data and information needs. A tutorial icon is available on the upper right side of the page.



## Accessing TnCrimeOnline

Agencies can access the Tennessee Crime Online site via "Law Enforcement Only" page on the [www.tbi.tn.gov](http://www.tbi.tn.gov) website, or by going directly to the web address provided below. Once you are on the homepage (shown above), click on the yellow link located in the blue box on the right side of the webpage under the TIBRS logo. You should then be prompted to enter your username (ORI number) and password (created by the agency).

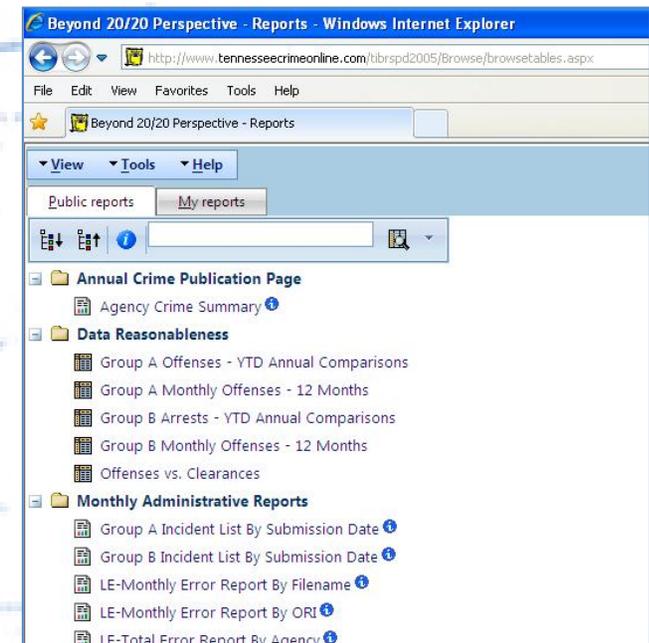
## How Can Your Agency Benefit From Using TnCrimeOnline?

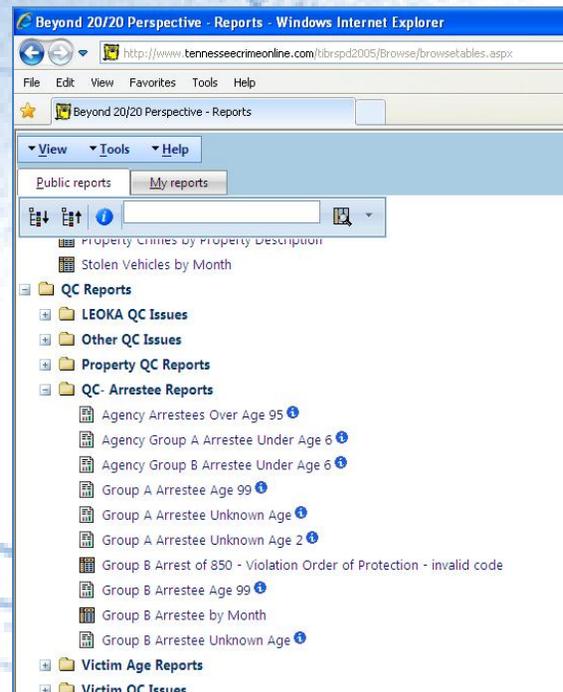
## What Reports Are Available?

The contributor site contains a series of reports that provide information on data levels, quality control issues and general administrative information such as:

- Crime in Tennessee page
- Crime on Campus
- Monthly Error Reports
- Quality Control Reports
- Incident Lists can be generated to compare agency vs. data at TBI

## How Often Is It Updated? How Soon Is My Data Available?

It is updated nightly and data availability is dependent upon when you submit your file (non TnCOP agencies). The day after your monthly TIBRS submission file is processed; the data will be available for your use on the website.



## How Do I Create My Own Reports?

The TnCrimeOnline page has two main tabs: *Public Reports* and *My Reports*. Agencies wishing to create new reports should do so in the *My Reports* tab. In this tab, agencies can title reports, organize them into folders, and select a data source for the report. The list of data sources available reflects the various TIBRS segments such as Offender, Victim, Arrests, Arrestee, etc. The type of report you wish to create will determine the data source you should select.

*Example: An agency wants to investigate the number of Aggravated Assaults reported where the Victim to Offender relationship was reported as Acquaintance.*

*In this case, it is most appropriate to use the Victim data source because TIBRS Victim to Offender relationship information is in the Victim segment.*
