REGARDING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Construction Division of the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), an Equal Opportunity Affirmative Action Employer, is seeking to retain a Construction Manager/ General Contractor (CM/GC) to provide preconstruction services, and potentially construction services, for SR- 14/ US-61 (Third Street) Bridges over ICRR and Noncannah Creek (L.M. 7.13), Interstate 55 Exit Ramp Bridge to State Route 14 (L.M. 7.44), and State Route 14 (South 3rd Street) Bridge over Interstate 55 (L.M. 7.46) in Shelby County, Tennessee (Contract **CMGC07**). TDOT is seeking a contractor with experience, at a minimum, in the following:

1. Bridge design and construction with Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) Experience.
2. Freeway design and construction.
3. Hydraulic design and construction; and
4. Environmental regulatory and compliance.

Failure of a contractor to attend any such meetings will result in elimination of that contractor, and any proposal submitted by that contractor will be rejected.
