

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS REGARDING INFORMATIONAL PROJECT MEETINGS

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), an Equal Opportunity Affirmative Action Employer, is seeking to retain the services of a design-builder to complete the **DB2504 Gallatin Pike (SR6) Safety Improvements** (Project) located in **Davidson** County.

An informational meeting will be held on **Tuesday, August 19, 2025, at 9:00 am CST** at the TDOT Region 3 Annex (6638 Centennial Blvd, Nashville, TN 37209). During this meeting, the proposers will learn about the Project, including the scope, goals, and design-build procurement schedule.

TDOT is also providing an opportunity for each interested proposer to request a confidential, 30-minute, one-on-one meeting following the informational meeting—at the same location listed above—to discuss any specific questions each proposer may have about the Project. TDOT is interested in receiving input from potential proposers on the following topics during the one-on-one meetings.

- 1) Interest in the Project (or concerns that may limit a proposer's pursuit of the Project)
- 2) Tailoring the project to incentivize new contractor participation in TDOT's alternatively delivered program
- 3) Scope and schedule questions

If interested in a one-on-one meeting, proposers (contractors only) should submit a request by **11:00 am CST** on **August 13, 2025** to <u>Jonathan.Vogel@tn.gov</u>. TDOT will notify each proposer of its individual meeting time after all requests have been received.

To help the proposer prepare for the informational meeting and subsequent one-on-one meetings, this meeting will present how TDOT intends to utilize the design-build (DB) contract to deliver the project and measures its employing to attract new contractor participation. TDOT is providing the Functional Level Design Plans and a Google Earth KML file that includes the locations for the Project's improvements to SR-6 Gallatin Pike.
