- 3. Qualification and availability of staff
- 4. Demonstrated ability to meet schedules without compromising sound engineering practice
- 5. Evaluations on prior TDOT projects , if available
- 6. Size of project and limited or unlimited pre-qualification status
- 7. Amount of work under contract with TDOT
