

## 2022 National Summer Transportation Host Site Application



The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is seeking Statement of Work (SOW) Applications for the 2022 National Summer Transportation Institute (NSTI) Program. **Any accredited institution of higher education may apply to serve as a host site for this program. The length of the program must be 4 consecutive weeks and the overall budget should not exceed \$50,000. Although there is no mandate to offer a virtual program, TDOT is very interested in proposals with virtual components if in person instruction is cancelled due to COVID -19 precautions.**

The NSTI program's objectives are to improve STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) skills, provide awareness to middle and high school students (rising 9-12 graders) – particularly minority, female and disadvantaged youth – about transportation careers, and encourage participants to consider transportation-related courses of study in their pursuit of higher education. The proposal must outline how at least 20-25 students or more will be recruited and areas of involvement.
