Rising grades 10-12th high school students**

The objectives of NSTI are to provide awareness of transportation careers to high school students, enhance participants STEM skills, and encourage participants to consider pursuing a transportation-related major in college. This program is administered by the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) and funded by the Federal Highway Administration; requiring no cost of the participant.

NSTI Includes:

- Seminars from Transportation Professionals
- Workshops and handouts
- Field trips
- Hand-on projects (traffic, bridge, drone, robotics)
- Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner
- ACT Preparation Course
- Certificate of participation

Application package Includes:

1. Official transcript is needed.
2. One recommendation letter from a school counselor;
3. One letter of recommendation from a computer science, mathematics, pre-engineering, or science teacher;
4. Proof of accident/health insurance, and
5. One (1) page typed essay describing their interest in STEM and more specifically engineering and transportation
