**Regarding Traffic Operations Strategies Included in Traffic Control Plan**


**Effective immediately**, section 4-712.00 is revised as noted. Projects already turned-in for the letting are exempt.

**PURPOSE:** This Instructional Bulletin is intended to ensure that traffic operational strategies indicated on the Traffic Management Plan are implemented during construction of the project.

**4-712.00 TRAFFIC CONTROL IN CONSTRUCTION ZONES**

For compliance with Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 630, Subpart J – Work Zone Safety and Mobility, all federally funded projects must have a Traffic Management Plan (TMP). The TMP shall be reviewed and finalized at the Constructability Field Review. The TMP shall at the minimum include a temporary traffic control plan which shall either be a project specific temporary traffic control plan, approved TDOT standard drawings or a reference to specific temporary traffic application in the MUTCD. Additionally, all Operational Strategies agreed to at the Constructability Field Review and included on the TMP shall be shown as a special note on the Traffic Control Plan in the project plans.
