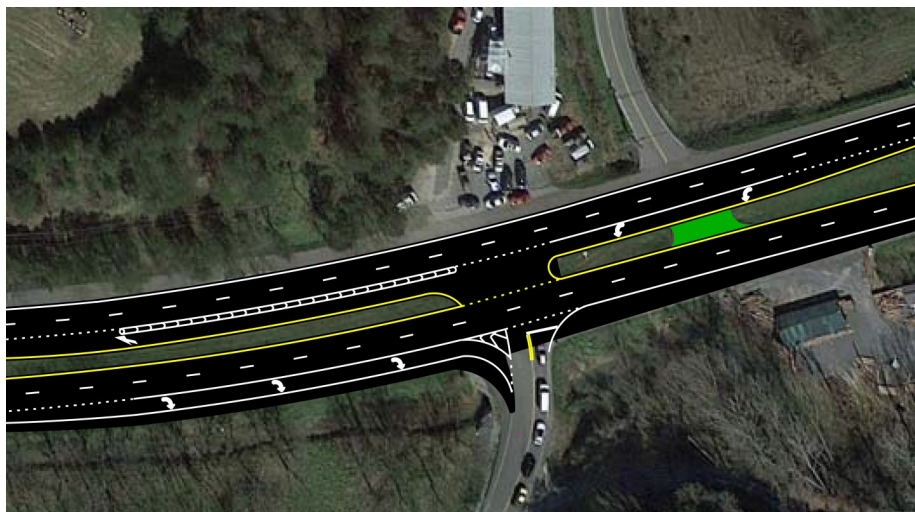

State Route 35, US-411, Chapman Highway, is a rural minor arterial located in Sevier County. The route spans east-west between Knoxville and Sevierville and has historically been the gateway to the Smoky Mountains. Pleasant Hill Road is a rural local roadway running north-south, providing a link from Chapman Highway to the Parkway in Sevierville and Pigeon Forge.

## CONCEPT FEATURES

- Installation of a right-turn lane onto Pleasant Hill Road
- Installation of an acceleration lane for vehicles turning left onto Chapman Highway from Pleasant Hill Road to have a safe area to accelerate to travel speeds
- Installation of a left-turn lane for vehicles on Chapman Highway entering Pleasant Hill Road
- Closure of median opening at Panther Creek Road in order to eliminate cross traffic
