


Goals of Transportation Planning Grants


Assist Tennessee communities with planning efforts that provide cohesiveness between multimodal transportation systems and local land use objectives to help achieve statewide transportation goals.

Provide local government with planning resources to achieve community visions related to transportation and land use that promote future economic growth.

Aid in the development of local planning documents that support improvements in traffic flow, safety, and overall efficiency of the transportation system.

Transportation Planning Grant Details

Rural and/or Metropolitan Areas

Eligible Applicants: Rural Cities and Counties (Jointly or Individually)

90% state, 10% local match*

\$200,000 total maximum grant award


*Counties & Municipalities within "distressed" or "at-risk" counties (FY2024) qualify for no local match but does not guarantee application will be selected for funding.

Other Grant Application Requirements?

- Prior to grant award, the grant application shall include a signed resolution of support from the applying jurisdiction(s) <u>AND</u> shall include an agreement to pay the 10% match if the grant is awarded (unless in distressed county).
- Once the project is complete, the plan shall be adopted by resolution.


