## Responses to questions/comments

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**Q1:** Are firms permitted to pursue multiple On-Call contracts across different regions? If so, should this be addressed within a single Letter of Interest, or does TDOT require a separate submission for each region?

**A1:** Yes, firms are permitted to pursue any and all of the items advertised. A separate Letter of Interest must be submitted for each item they are interested in pursuing.

**Q2:** The scope references “new and emerging technologies.” Are there specific technologies (e.g., mobile LiDAR, SLAM-based mapping, AI-assisted feature extraction) that TDOT is particularly interested in deploying or piloting under this contract?

**A2:** We are interested in the technologies listed as well as others that a firm may possess or be aware of either now or during the life of the contract.

**Q3:** With respect to the development and delivery of training on survey processes and workflows, does TDOT anticipate formal classroom instruction, field-based demonstrations, or documentation-only deliverables?

**A3:** Yes, it could be any or a combination.

**Q4:** When are the Prequalification Statements due?

**A4:** April 27, 2026.
