Q1: If known, when is this project expected to go to bid for contractors?

A1: At the time of advertisement, the project was scheduled in the 10-Year Plan for FY32 construction. However, the project schedule has since been updated and the project is now anticipated for FY30 construction.¹

Q2: Would TDOT allow a proposed Project Manager's prior experience from previous employers to be included in Section F ("Example Projects Which Best Illustrate Proposed Team's Qualifications for This Contract") when those projects did not involve a firm listed in Section C of the proposed team? If so, how should firms address the requirement to identify "firms from Section C involved with this project" when highlighting relevant experience that predates the individual's current firm?

A2: Yes. Relevant project experience performed by proposed key personnel at previous employers may be included in Section F, provided the experience is within the allowable time period and is clearly relevant to the advertised contract. For Item 25, firms should identify the proposed Section C firm with which the individual is currently associated and describe that the example project experience was performed by the individual while employed by a previous firm. The response should clearly distinguish between the experience of the individual and the experience of the proposing team firms.

Q3: What is the deadline for sending questions for firm selected to proceed in Phase II.

A3: No later than 3:00 pm CST May 25th, 2026
