**Project Specific Engineering Services for SR-11 (US 31A/41A), From Near Sunset Road to Near Burkitt
Road in Nolensville (PIN 133919.00), Williamson County RFP**

Responses to questions/comments

Q1: We reviewed the recent RFQ posted for Engineering Services for SR-11 (US 31A/41A), From Near Sunset Road to Near Burkitt Road in Nolensville (PIN 133919.00), Williamson County. What is the anticipated schedule for construction for this project?

A1: The project is currently scheduled to begin PE in FY 2027, ROW in FY 2030, and Construction in FY 2036.

Q2: NEPA and environmental services are not specifically identified within the Scope of Services. Can TDOT confirm whether the selected consultant will be required to provide environmental and/or NEPA-related services under this contract?

A2: All NEPA and environmental Services will be completed by TDOT.

Q3: There appears to be a relatively large drainage crossing just south of Kidd Road; however, bridge design is not included in the advertised Scope of Services. Does TDOT anticipate that this crossing can be accommodated without bridge design services, or will any required bridge design be performed under a separate contract?

A3: TDOT anticipates that the existing three-barrel slab culvert can be accommodated without the need for bridge design services.

Q4: Mill Creek runs parallel to portions of the project corridor, and impacts to the floodplain and potentially the floodway may be encountered. Are hydraulic and hydrologic (H&H) services expected to be included within the scope of this contract, or will these services be procured separately?

A4: All Hydraulic and Hydrologic Services will be completed by TDOT.

Q5: The Scope of Services includes Concept Services. Can TDOT clarify whether this encompasses the full range of Stage 1 Concept Development activities identified in the Project Development Network (PDN), or whether a more limited concept-level effort is anticipated?

A5: Concept Services will encompass the full range of Stage 1 Concept Development activities identified in the Project Delivery Network.

Q6: Has a proposed typical section been established for the project, or will development of the typical section be included as part of the Concept Services effort?

A6: Development of the proposed typical section will be included as part of Concept Services.

Q7: Has a conceptual plan already been developed for this project?

A7 No, a conceptual plan has not yet been developed for this project. All PDN Stage 1 Concept Activities will be the responsibility of the selected consultant.
