PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project involves traffic signal modifications and implementation of updated traffic signal timing at 44 intersections throughout the City of Brentwood. Project also includes sidewalk/curb ramp replacements, pavement markings, and traffic signage. The project length is 1.055 miles. The proposal contract specifies a completion time of on or before 270 calendar days after the start notice is issued.
