



NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS REGARDING A REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Tullahoma, Tennessee, seeks to retain the services of a professional consulting firm(s) to provide **Appraisal Services** for Right of Way and Easement acquisition associated with the Ledford Mill Road Widening Project (PIN# 125070.00). This project involves the widening of Ledford Mill Road from the Tullahoma Airport Business Park to SR-16. This project received funding through the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) as a Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) Locally Managed Project. This project shall adhere to all applicable Federal and State regulations and requirements. The project shall be accomplished in accordance with the project application on which TDOT approval was based. Responsibilities of the professional consultant firm include, but are not limited to:

Required Scope of Services

- Coordinate with the Engineer of Record (St. John Engineering, LLC) on Right-of-Way and easement information, tract information, site survey, parcel data, etc.
- Prepare appraisals of all tracts indicated on the ROW Plans.

Estimated Schedule for Performance of Work

- Complete the appraisals within 3 months.
- Complete the review appraisals within 1 month of the appraisals.
- Commence with negotiations with 1 month of receipt of signed, approved appraisals.

RFQ Criteria

Firms may request consideration by delivering a Qualifications Submittal Package and Prequalification Form (DT-0330, Part 1) to **Paige Jackson, Assistant Finance Director, City of Tullahoma, 201 West Grundy Street, Tullahoma, TN 37388**. All Qualifications Submittal Packages must be received on or before **10:00 a.m. Central Standard Time September 9, 2026**. All packages includes 3 hardcopies of the package and 1 electronic copy.

Evaluation

The City of Tullahoma will evaluate the respondents on the following criteria (relative weight):

- a. Workload capacity; including amount of work under contract with the City of Tullahoma, if applicable (20%)
- b. Past performance on City of Tullahoma projects (20%)
- c. Technical approach (e.g., project understanding, innovative concepts or alternatives, quality control procedures) (20%)
- d. Demonstrated ability to meet schedules without compromising sound practice (20%)
- e. Past experience related to the performance of appraisal services specifically for TDOT funded projects (20%)

The consultant evaluation committee holds the ability to conduct interviews based on scoring during the Evaluation.

All firms must be pre-qualified or have a completed prequalification form filed with the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) by the deadline for the letters of interest. The letter of interest shall not specifically identify sub-consultant(s), but rather shall indicate the scope of services anticipated to be completed by any sub-consultant(s). The sub-consultant shall be a firm that is prequalified by TDOT to perform the specific tasks required. A pending prequalification status will be acceptable. Please include a valid email address and phone number for the point-of-contact.
