PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Duck River Greenway Reconstruction and Scenic Overlook in Shelbyville, Bedford County: This project involves the widening and reconstruction of the Duck River Greenway beginning at the River Bottom Park and ending at SR-10/South Cannon Blvd, which is approximately 0.286 miles long. The project also involves the construction of a new scenic river 1200 SF overlook open-air structure, decorative pedestrian fencing, pedestrian greenway lighting, landscaping, and invasive species removal along the riverbank.

PROPOSAL CONTRACTS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE TIME SET FOR OPENING BIDS

A Prime Contractor must prequalify with the Department of Transportation in accordance with Section 54-5-117 of the “Tennessee Code Annotated” and the Tennessee Department of Transportation Rule 1680-5-3 prequalification of contractors before biddable proposals will be furnished.
