

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation seeks comments on Amendment #335 to the 2026-2029 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendment #335 is for Cumberland County and TDOT is proposing a new Surface Transportation Improvement Project (STIP), Rural Amend 335, STIP ID 23182299063, PIN 134487.00, Westel Road (State Route 299), from near Pig Path Road to near the I-40 west bound ramps, (Flat Rock) Transportation Modernization Act, a length of 0.673 miles. The project will consist of widening Westel Road (SR-299) from 2 to 5 lanes, adding turn lanes, improving ramps, and replacing the current 2-lane bridge over I-40 with a 5-lane bridge. Right-of-Way cost is \$3,453,000 fiscal year (FY) 2026 STBG (Surface Transportation Block Grant) funds, 80% federal (\$2,762,400) and 20% state (\$690,600). Total project cost is estimated at \$29,753,000. TDOT is managing the project”.
