RE: Proposed FY 2022-2024 Comprehensive Multimodal Program

As part of Governor Lee's budget, the Department of Transportation is including the enclosed FY 2022-2024 Comprehensive Multimodal Program for your information. This program contains components for highway projects, bridges, transit, rail, waterway, and aviation projects, as well as statewide initiatives and is intended as supporting data for the budget request of the Department's FY 2022 budget. In addition to the FY 2022 budgeted program are partial plans for FY 2023 and FY 2024 for planning purposes.

The highway project listing component of the program identifies funding for environmental studies, preliminary engineering, right-of-way activities, and construction on 68 individual project phases located in 45 counties across the state, including operations and statewide initiatives. Additionally, the bridge component of the program initiates activities on 55 bridges in 33 counties, 21 on state routes and 34 on local roads.

The Comprehensive Multimodal Program supports Governor Lee's first Executive Order by funding work on 58 highway and bridge projects in economically distressed and at-risk counties. The program also continues to build on the legacy of the IMPROVE Act, budgeting dollars for 123 of the 962 projects identified in the legislation.

This 3-year program will continue to fund initiatives to maintain pavements & bridges, improve safety, address congestion through our HELP & Incident Management Programs, improve mobility for people & freight, and other programs to maintain a state of good repair on the state highway network. These investments are critical in providing a safe and reliable transportation system that supports economic growth and quality of life.
