

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation seeks comments on Amendment #272 to the 2023-2026 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendment #272 is for Hawkins County and involves TDOT widening SR-66 from two 10-foot lanes to two 12-foot lanes, from SR-34 in Bulls Gap to near Speedwell Road/Old Highway 66, Hawkins, Co., a distance of 5.7 miles. ROW is being increased from \$6,800,000 to \$52,000,000 for FY 2026 Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds at 80/20 federal/state. Total project cost increases from \$77,400,000 to \$147,620,227. TDOT will manage the project.
