

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation seeks comments on Amendment #270 to the 2023-2026 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendment #270 is for Hawkins County and involves TDOT constructing spot improvements on SR-31, including widening, adding a turn lane at Helton Drive, and replacing the bridge over Mooresburg Branch and Poor Valley Creek on State Route 31, from the community of Mooresburg to Adams Lane in Hawkins County, a distance of 4.25 miles. \$15,906,816 for construction is provided for fiscal year 2026, \$12,725,452 federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds and \$3,181,364 state funds. Total project cost is estimated at \$19,514,721. TDOT will manage the project.
