• TDOT will build a new interchange on Interstate 40 near Mile Marker 408 in Sevier County east of existing Exit 407 on State Route 66. There will also be a connector road built through the interchange extending from Douglas Dam Road (State Route 139) on the south to East Dumplin Valley Road on the north. Funds for Preliminary Engineering-NEPA (PEN) are provided for fiscal year (FY) 2026; \$7,372,770 at 100% state as part of the Transportation Modernization Act (TMA) and \$7,372,769 in National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) funds at 80/20 federal /state. Total project cost is estimated at \$189,048,696.
