

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation seeks comments on Amendment #239 to the 2023-2026 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendment #239: TDOT is amending a Polk County project. TDOT is adding a new project to the 2023-2026 Rural STIP. It is a roadway realignment, widening from two lanes to three lanes, and rockfall mitigation, State Route 40 (US-64), Log Mile 8.58 to 9.96. The project is 0.61 miles long, from near the parking area of East Parksville Boat Ramp to near State Route 30, excluding L.M. 9.19 - 9.69 (Corridor K TA Locations #10 & #12), Polk Co. Preliminary Engineering for the Environmental Phase (PE-N) utilizes \$1,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2026 Appalachian Development Program (APD) 100% federal funds. The total project cost is \$27,730,000. The project is managed by TDOT”.
