RE: FTA Section 5339 FFY2017 Partial Year Program Allocation

Dear Small Urban Transit Agencies:

The FTA recently announced the FFY2017 5339 Small Urban Partial Apportionment, comprising of about 7/12ths (October 1, 2016 – April 28, 2017) of the total apportionment. TDOT is issuing this split allocation letter to enable Tennessee's small urban agencies to apply directly to the FTA for these 5339 funds.

TDOT Multimodal is pleased to announce the allocation of FTA Section 5339 partial year program funds for Federal Fiscal Year 2017. Allocations are determined by formula. Factors include the UZA population reported by the 2010 US Census, as well as verified 2015 National Transit Database (NTD) data for Revenue Miles, Unlinked Passenger Trips, and Local Participation.

The table below shows the funds allocated to each small urbanized area.

Small urban agencies may not suballocate 5339 funds to other agencies. TDOT Multimodal offers state match on the 5339 capital funds. Contracts will have a one-year term period at time of request, unless circumstances exist that require a period beyond one year, which will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Funds allocated are subject to redistribution if not obligated by the deadline.

The table below indicates the period of availability for all 5339 funds.
