# Public Design Hearing

SR-48 (Trenton Rd), from near SR-374 to near I-24 in Montgomery County, TN

### Thank you for attending the State Route 48 Design Public Hearing.

The proposed project includes the widening of State Route 48 to five lanes with a two-way left turn lane. The southern terminus of the road will be just south of State Route 374 (101st Airborne Division Pkwy). An innovative solution referred to as Continuous-Flow Intersection is recommended at the intersection State Route 374 (101st Airborne Division Pkwy) to help with traffic flow and safety. There will be intersection improvements at Needmore Rd, Hazelwood Rd, Meriwether Rd, State Route 236 (Tiny Town Rd), I-24, and Tylertown Rd. The intersection of Proposed Spring Creek Pkwy will be included in the improvements of State Route 48. The northern terminus will conclude north of Tylertown Rd. The recommended improvements along State Route 48 will include four foot shoulders, curb and gutter, and five foot sidewalks as well as improvements at intersections of side roads along the roadway for improved safety and ADA compliance.

In total, the proposed improvements for the combined segments along State Route 48 will include approximately 4.24 miles of roadway construction work.




