Broadway Viaduct Replacement

SR 1/U.S. 70 Davidson County



Completed Work:

Project Overview

The project along State Route 1 (US 70) consists of replacing the bridge, also known as the Broadway Viaduct, that crosses over 11th Avenue and the CSX Railroad in downtown Nashville, Davidson County.

Built in 1948, the bridge is nearing the end of its life cycle. Through its lifetime, the bridge has seen two major rehabilitation projects and is beginning to show additional deterioration. This project will not only improve this gateway to downtown Nashville but will also improve safety by increasing the bridge's vertical clearance over the railroad tracks and help prepare for continued development in the area.

Construction will include a complete closure of the bridge between July 5, 2023, and September 1, 2023. Drivers will be detoured around the closure via Church St. and Demonbreun Street.
