



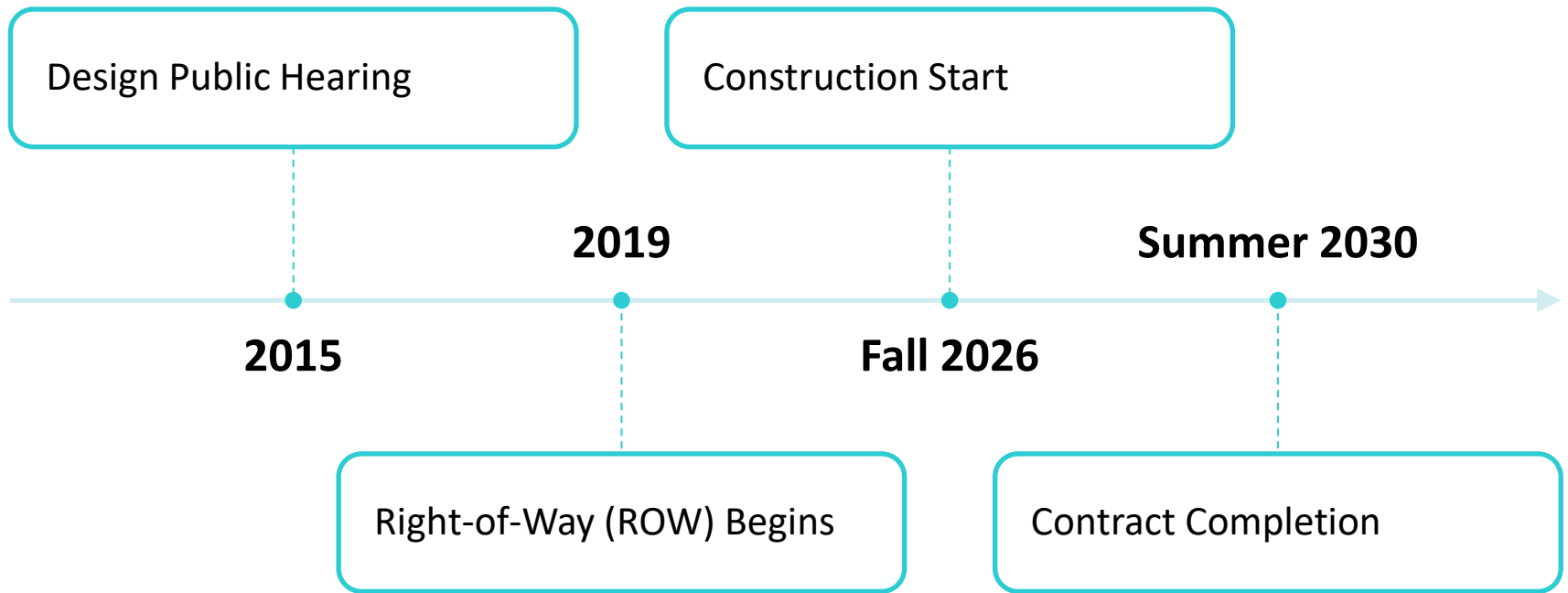
SR 268/N. Thompson Lane Widening

History & Anticipated Timeline



Project Information & Purpose

- **Widening** SR 268 to a constant five-lane facility throughout termini to better meet current and projected traffic volumes.
- **Replacing** the bridge over West Fork Stones River to meet current bridge specifications.
- **Adding** sidewalks on both sides of the corridor, as well as a shared-use path from the bridge over West Fork Stones River to near Memorial Boulevard to better serve pedestrians and trail users.
- Four **signal upgrades**, three **signal additions**, and a **Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB)** for increased safety and efficiency.

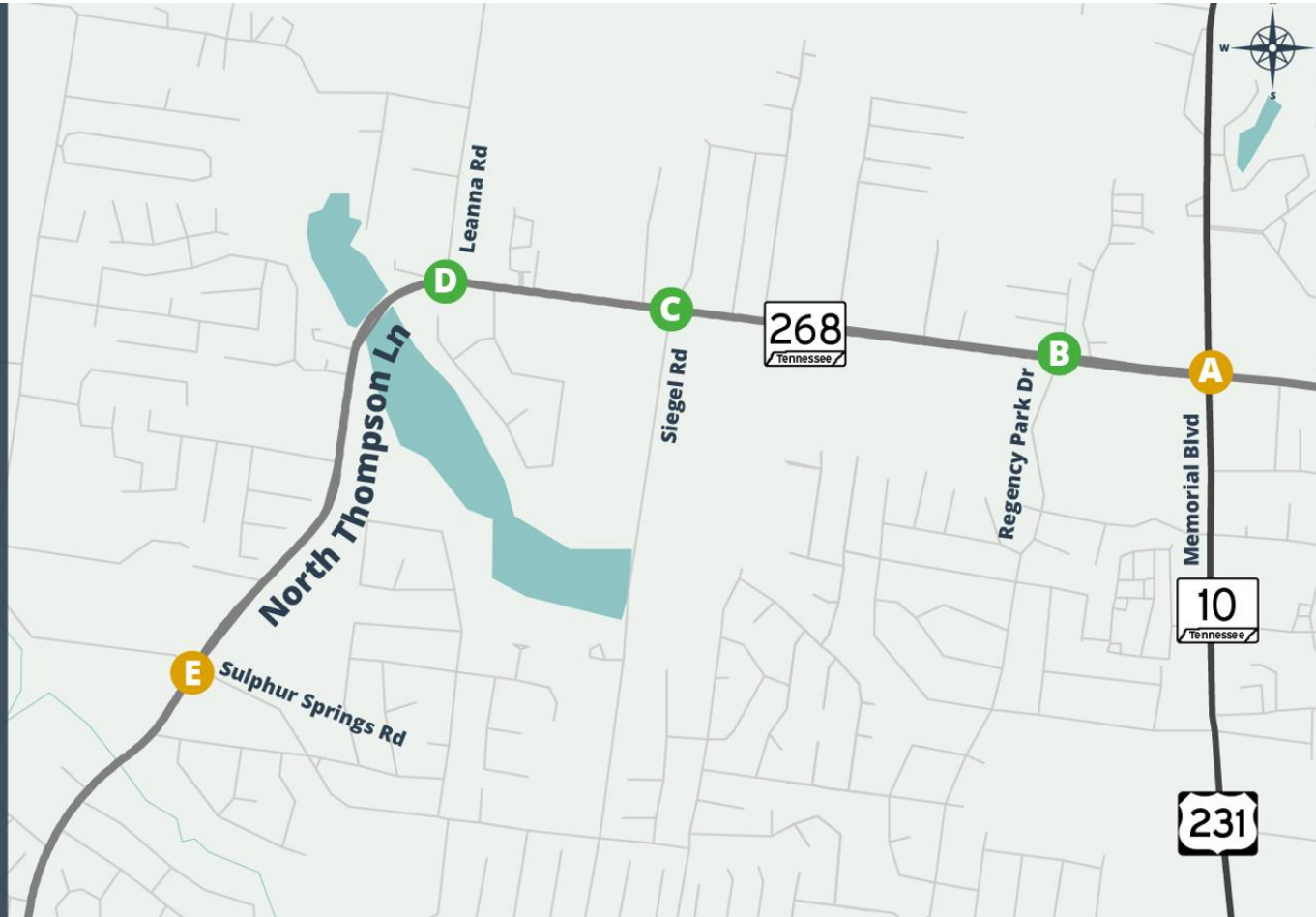

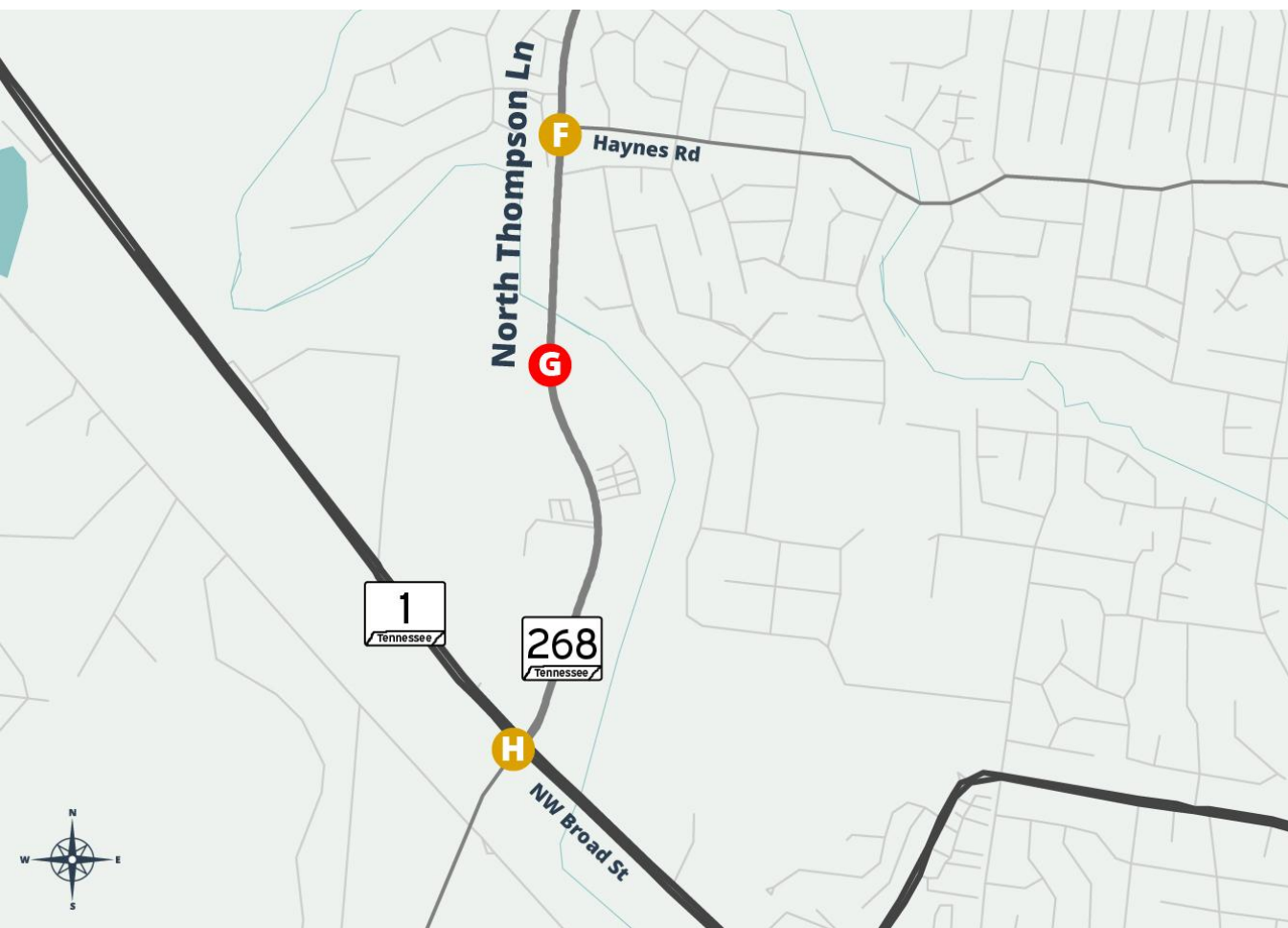

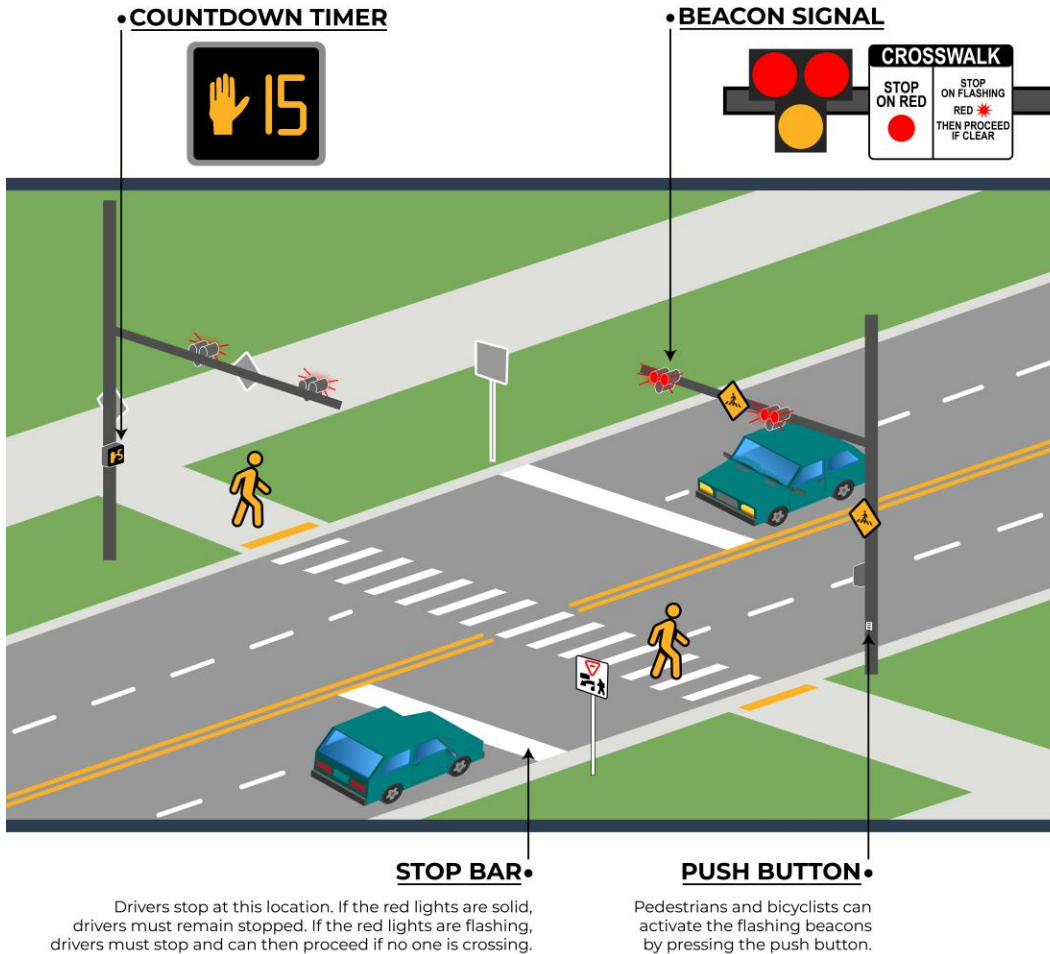

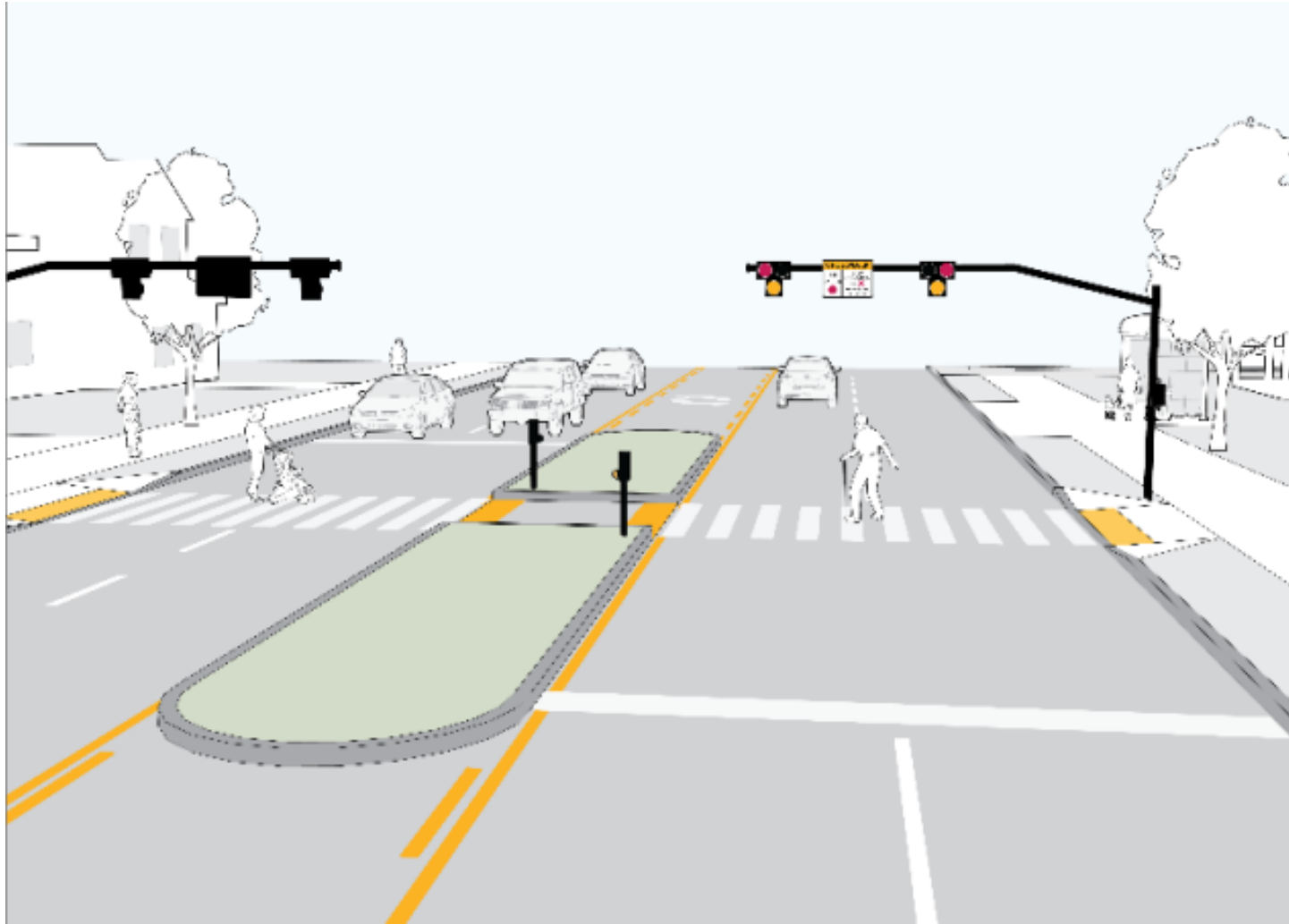

Anticipated Impacts

- **Bike lanes closed** during construction
- **Lane closures permitted 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** when school is in session
- **Lane closures permitted 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.** when school is **not** in session
- **Crosswalk** changes upon completion
- *More detailed timeline and phases to be shared after pre-construction coordination with the contractor.*

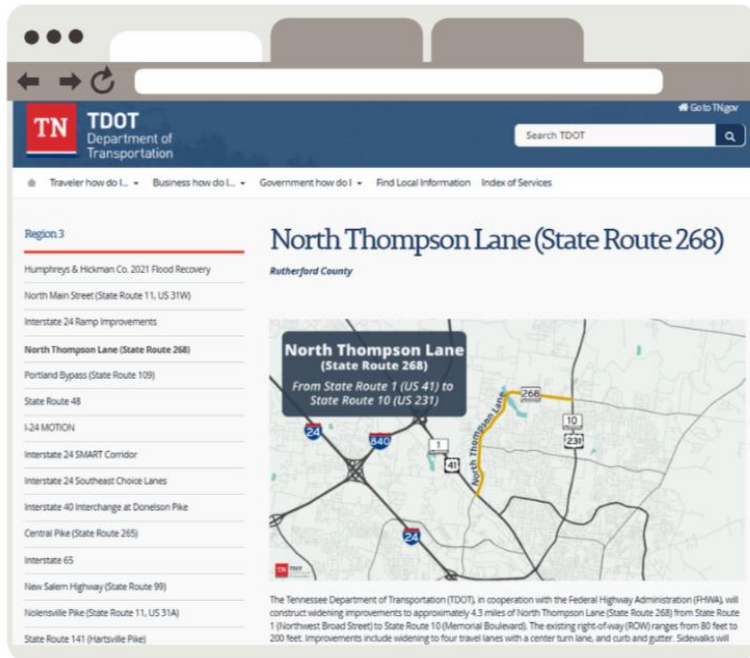
Crosswalk Change Upon Completion



Anticipated Impacts

- **Closure** of the Thompson Lane Trailhead Canoe Ramp
 - Alternative boater access points will be signed & information posted to project website
- **Access to McFadden Farm & Thompson Lane Trailhead/Stones River Greenway will be maintained**
 - Section of greenway beneath bridge will be **closed** while bridge is being constructed
