Project Updates

Crews are only permitted to work on Cumberland Drive when school isn't in session, so we'll be closing a section of Cumberland Drive near Fairview Boulevard the week of October 6. Details are below, and don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions.

Project Description

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is constructing an improvement project along State Route 100 (Fairview Boulevard) in Fairview, from the Fairview Recreation Center to near Bowie Lake Road.

Project components include the installation of curb and gutter, a storm drainage system, and 5-foot sidewalks in the following areas:

- From the Fairview Recreation Center to King Road: Sidewalks on the westbound side of SR 100
- From King Road to Cumberland Drive/Crow Cut Road: Sidewalks on both sides of SR 100
- From Cumberland Drive/Crow Cut Road to Bowie Lake Road: Sidewalks on the westbound side of SR 100

Improvements also include the installation of dedicated left turn lanes, a new traffic signal, and school zone flashing signage at Crow Cut Road and Cumberland Drive.

Completed Work:

Advanced warning signs at each end of the project and on side roads are now installed. You'll also find a bulletin board by the school that outlines project contact information if you have any questions while this work is ongoing.

Active Work:

Utility work is continuing.

Upcoming Work:

Starting next week, the contractor will begin work grading Cumberland Drive and installing storm drains around the intersection with Fairview Boulevard. This work will consist of bringing the road down to grade, installing storm drains and box culverts.

Traffic Impacts:

To complete that intersection work, we will close Cumberland Drive at the Fairview Boulevard intersection starting Monday, October 6 (see map below). A detour will be in place, routing motorists from Fairview Boulevard to Dogwood Drive. This work will cover just a small section of Cumberland Drive and the entrance to Fairview Community Church will still be accessible. This work is scheduled to be complete by Friday, October 10.



We understand there has been increased congestion as utility work and flagging continues on Fairview Boulevard. We are working with the utility company to resolve the traffic issues and will continue to monitor the situation to examine whether lane closures need to be altered.

For now, this work is permitted weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please consider taking an alternate route.
