



Fairview Boulevard (State Route 100) Improvements

September 18, 2026

Project Description

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is constructing an improvement project along State Route 100 (Fairview Boulevard) in Fairview, from the Fairview Recreation Center to near Bowie Lake Road.

Project components include the installation of curb and gutter, a storm drainage system, and 5-foot sidewalks in the following areas:

- From the Fairview Recreation Center to King Road: Sidewalks on the westbound side of SR 100
- From King Road to Cumberland Drive/Crow Cut Road: Sidewalks on both sides of SR 100
- From Cumberland Drive/Crow Cut Road to Bowie Lake Road: Sidewalks on the westbound side of SR 100

Improvements also include the installation of dedicated left turn lanes, a new traffic signal, and school zone flashing signage at Crow Cut Road and Cumberland Drive.

Completed & Current Work

- Temporary signal installed.
- Storm drain work completed.
- Majority of curb & gutter work completed.
- Sidewalk construction is beginning at the west end of the project.
- Topsoil and sod is being placed behind the sidewalk.



Remaining Work

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Estimated Completion in October:

- Driveways and finishing remaining curb & gutter work
- Placing top paving layer on entire project footprint
- Final striping
- Installing sod
- Installing crosswalks near Crow Cut Road and Cumberland Drive

Estimated Completion in November:

- Installing permanent signals on Crow Cut Road & Cumberland Drive (pole delivery delayed)
- Installing flashing school beacon
