

Nolensville Pike / State Route 11 Widening Newsletter

Late April/Early May 2025

Phase 1 Project Description:

The project widens Nolensville Pike from a two-lane to a five-lane road (including a dedicated turn lane and bike lanes). It stretches from south of Burkitt Road to near SR 254 (Old Hickory Boulevard). The project includes reconstruction and widening for approximately 4.4 miles. The proposed improvements are intended to address congestion, improve safety, and accommodate growth in this rapidly developing area.

Due to the size of improvements to SR 11, TDOT has split this project into two phases. Phase One, from north of Mill Creek to near SR 254 in southern Davidson County, is currently under construction.

Phase One Progress

- Completed Work:
 - Storm drainage structures placed
 - Buried utilities (water, sewer, and gas) installed
 - Utility poles and overhead electric placed along the south end of the project (Bluff Road to Shane Point Place)
 - Holt Road construction:
 - Phase One grading completed
 - New utility poles installed with overhead electric lines
 - Overhead communication lines relocated
 - Blasting for Phase Two completed
 - Retaining walls two, three, and seven completed

Active Work:

- o Pouring concrete wall panels for retaining wall five
- Setting utility poles and placing overhead electric along the north end of the project (Shane Point Place to Old Hickory Boulevard)
- o Grading operations throughout the project
- Water, sewer, and gas installation
- Phase One storm drainage placement
- Telecommunication relocations along the new utility poles from the beginning of project to Shane Point Place
- o Holt Road construction: Phase Two grading

Upcoming Work:

- Phase One storm drainage placement
- Water, sewer, and gas installation
- Holt Road construction:
 - Storm drainage and underground utility placement
 - Placing curb and base stone
 - Asphalt paving
- Phase one of the arch culvert that crosses Nolensville Pike to be installed on the north end of the project
