

# Nolensville Pk. / State Route 11 Widening

# June 2024

## Phase 1 Project Description:

The project widens Nolensville Pike from a two-lane to a 5-lane road (including a dedicated turn lane and bike lanes). It stretches from south of Burkitt Road to near SR 254 (Old Hickory Boulevard). The project includes the reconstruction and widening for approximately 4.4 miles. The proposed improvements are intended to address congestion, improve safety, and accommodate growth in this rapidly developing area.

Due to the size of improvements to SR 11, TDOT has split this project into two phases. Phase 1, from north of Mill Creek to near SR 254 in southern Davidson County, is currently under construction.

#### Completed Work:

- Clearing of south end of the project.
- Phase 1 Traffic Pattern established.



#### Active Work:

- Blasting and grading work will continue.
- Additional stream relocation work.

- Continued underground utility relocation.
- Overhead utility relocation.
