Nolensville Pk. / State Route 11 Widening

July 2024

Phase 1 Project Description:

The project widens Nolensville Pike from a two-lane to a 5-lane road (including a dedicated turn lane and bike lanes). It stretches from south of Burkitt Road to near SR 254 (Old Hickory Boulevard). The project includes the reconstruction and widening for approximately 4.4 miles. The proposed improvements are intended to address congestion, improve safety, and accommodate growth in this rapidly developing area.

Due to the size of improvements to SR 11, TDOT has split this project into two phases. Phase 1, from north of Mill Creek to near SR 254 in southern Davidson County, is currently under construction.

Completed Work:

- Most of the available clearing options are complete
- Barrier wall installed throughout project



Active Work:

- Blasting and grading
- Additional stream mitigation

- Installing drainage structures
- Sewer line installation
- Water line materials



Upcoming Work:

- Grading operations with blasting as needed
- Stream mitigation work will continue
- Drainage structure installation will continue
- Underground utility relocation will continue
- Materials for overhead utility relocations will be delivered
- Retaining wall construction
